Dear Ladies and Gentleman, dear IBU-members,

We are looking back on a successful year 2014 and are pleased and confident: 243 new EPDs were published in 2014 and several new members joined us, opting for our programme. We are ready for more to come in 2015. As the rising figures of EPDs and IBU members show, sustainable construction has become even more relevant and is a trend that is increasingly gaining ground. Internationally as well as Europe-wide we have made considerable progress. Various national programme holders joined forces and created the ECO-Platform, a European joint venture. This year its



members agreed on the mutual recognition of common quality and verifying standards. For the European standardization of EPDs this has been quite a milestone. In 2014 EPD Norge became our third partner to mutually recognize each other's programmes.

As of the end of this year, there will be an interface connecting the IBU database system to the new ÖKOBAUDAT. From then on, IBU declaration owners are able to transfer their life cycle assessment data straight from the EPD online tool into the ÖKOBAUDAT.

In order to support our members in communicating the content of their EPDs and to make sustainability even better known to the public, we conducted several workshops on different subjects, visited numerous fairs and gave many presentations. In 2015 we will continue to attach great importance to that and promote the value of EPDs to the different target groups. Therefore, we developed a new communication concept in 2014, which we will gradually implement as from the beginning of the next year. As a result IBU and its EPD programme will shift even more into the focus of attention.

I would like to take the opportunity and express my gratitude to all IBU staff here at the Berlin office for their excellent work and to all members of the various IBU committees. We would not have been so successful without everyone's tireless efforts.

The new year will start with our stand at BAU 2015. At two different stands we will direct people's attention to EPDs and current national and international developments.

For now, the IBU team wishes you, your families and beloved ones a peaceful and Merry Christmas and a healthy, lucky and successful Happy New Year.

IBU on BAU 2015: Visit us!


IBU will have its own stand at BAU 2015 from 19th to 24th January and will inform fair visitors about construction products and the importance of sustainable construction.

During a live presentation IBU members will show you how they are transferring their EPD data via the new IBU database interface to the federal construction materials database ÖKOBAUDAT. Auditors, planners and engineers use ÖKOBUADAT to access information on building assessments. When using the online tool eLCA, life-cycle assessments for entire construction parts and groups can be created by looking at the environmental impact of single construction products. In cooperation with BBSR (Federal Institute for Research on Building, Urban Affairs and Spatial Development) we will show you how to proceed.
